HPCL Biofuels Limited (hereafter called HBL) whose registered office is situated at 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Shree Sadan, Nr Indian Overseas Bank, Pataliputra Colony Golambar, Opposite Ruban Hospital, Patna-800 013, A wholly subsidiary of Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited, Govt. of India Enterprise (hereafter called HPCL) invites this auction for the supply of <u>Preprinted high quality</u> food grade poly propylene (pp) bags with liner, of 50 kg Net capacity for sugar packing on F.O.R./Free Door Delivery basis to HBL plants at Sugauli, East Champaran and Lauriya, West Champaran as per auction documents (herein after referred to as "PP Bags"). Participants shall be technically and financially competent to carry out the contract /supplies.

#### **SCOPE OF THE SUPPLIER:**

The scope of the supplier for supplying Preprinted high quality food grade poly propylene (PP) woven bags (sacks) with liner, of 50 kg Net capacity of sugar packing on door delivery (including transportation, loading & unloading charge) basis at the following address of HPCL Biofuels Limited:

#### Important Note to Bidders: -

- 1. Participant may bid for either or for both the Parts.
- 2. Please note that e-Auction for Part-A & Part-B shall be done separately and independently for the successful bidder (L-1 & L-2) on this part. Participants to bid for the entire quantity of this part, which includes landed cost i.e including taxes, duties, levies etc. complete.
- 3. Scope of the supply also includes Transportation, Loading & Unloading charges of "PP Sacks" at Lauriya and Sugauli Plant.
- 4. Participants to quote their price/rate considering above mentioned scope of supply of "PP Bags".
- 5. P.O. for Part-A, shall be placed among two suppliers in the ratio of 60:40 for each location. L-1 will be given 60% quantity and L-2 will be given 40% of the quantity, subject to L-2 matches the L-1 rate.

- 6. P.O. for Part-B, shall be placed among two suppliers in the ratio of 60:40 for each location. L-1 will be given 60% quantity and L-2 will be given 40% of the quantity, subject to L-2 matches the L1 rate.
- 7. Delivery Period: Delivery to be made within 15 days from the date of intimation thru mail/letter/call up.
- 8. Purchase Order Validity: The Purchase order when placed shall be valid for 12 months for execution from the date of LOI / Purchase Order, whichever is earlier for delivery on lot basis as per HBL's advice.
- 9. Payment shall be released within 30 days from the date of receipt of HBL certified bill at accounts department of the respective Sugar Plant.

The scope of the supplier for respective parts includes Supply, Transportation, loading & unloading of "PP Woven Sacks" on door delivery basis at HBL Sugauli / Lauriya Plant.

#### **TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS**

Specifications as per Indian standard specification no. IS 14968:2015 and latest as amended up to date, for Food grade High Density POLYPROPYLENE (PP) woven sacks with liner for packing of 50 Kg. of Sugar.

#### 1. Manufacture

- a. Raw Material: The tape shall be manufactured from virgin high density POLYPROPYLENE (PP) conforming to requirement specified in IS 10146.
- **b.** Fabric: The fabric used in the manufacture of PP Woven sacks shall be woven as a tube on circular loom from PP bags having width of 2.5 mm conforming to IS6192 or 11197. The fabric shall be tightly woven having crushed tapes so that the sugar does not ooze out from the sack. The constructional particulars of fabric shall be as given in Table 1 of the IS specification no. IS 14968:2015 and latest as amended to date.

#### c. Sack: -

i. Bottom seam: The stitching of bottom seam shall be done with two rows of chain stitch (see IS 10789/ISO 4915). The two rows of stitched shall be separated from each other by minimum 4 mm and the outer stitch shall be minimum 7 mm from the outer edge of the sacks. The stitching shall be done with double fold over seam to a depth of minimum 25 mm, so that the stitched pass through a minimum of six layers of at the fabric for 50 Kg sack. The number of stitches/dm shall be 14±2. The material used to stitch shall be PP tape. The stitching shall be uniform without any loose thread or knot.

- ii. Mouth: The completely open mouth of the sack shall be hemmed with a fold of minimum 25 mm and tapes shall not fray. The loose liner, if required, shall be inserted inside the sack and shall be hemmed into the mouth with single hem.
- iii. Liner: The liner to be of food grade virgin PP conforming to IS 10146. The width of the loose liner shall be 10 percent more than the width of the sack. The thickness of the loose liner, when tested in accordance with A-2 of IS 2508 shall be 70 μm± 5 percent in case of PP. The bottom seam of the loose liner shall be at least 25 mm from the bottom edge. The liner shall be free from pin holes, patches, tears, blisters and any other visible defects.
- iv. Drop Test: Filled bag drop from 10ft height. Incase shall be intact not matching the specification whole lot shall be rejected.

#### 2. Requirements

- a. The sacks shall confirm to the requirement specified in Table 1 of the IS Specification no. IS 14968:2015 and latest as mended up to date.
- **b.** UV Resistance: The PP Woven fabric of sack made out of UV stabilized material shall have atleast 50 percent of the original breaking strength when tested.
- c. Mass of bale: Mass of bale of sacks (excluding packing material) shall be within ±3 per cent of the mass calculated by multiplying the number of sacks with the mass of sack specified in the table 1 of the IS specification No.IS 14968:2015.

### 3. Printing, Packing and Marking

- a. Printing on Sacks: The sack shall be printed in black/dark blue colour conforming to IS 9833 with identification mark of sack manufacturer along with the information as required by the buyer using suitable ink by flexography.
- **b.** Packing: The sacks shall be packed to form a bale using a layer of PP Woven fabric and suitably secured. The bale shall contain 500 sacks and multiple thereof.
- c. Average weight per bag of truck loaded 180 gm (excluding packing and binding material) minimum individual bag weight 172.8 gm whole lot will be rejected if any bag found less than 172.8 gm.

### d. Marking

The bales shall be marked with the following information:

- Name of the Manufacture
- Type and size of sacks

- Gross mass
- Net mass
- Month and year of manufacture, and
- FSSAI License no.
- Any other information required by buyer.
- e. BIS Certification Marking: Each bale containing PP sacks may also be marked with the Standard Mark. The use of the Standard Mark is governed by the provisions of the Bureau of Indian Standard Act 1986 and Rules and regulations made there under. The details of conditions under which the license for the use of the Standard Mark may be granted to manufacturers or producers may be obtained from the bureau of Indian Standards.

# 4. Atmospheric Conditions for Conditioning and Testing

Prior to test the specifications shall be conditioned to moisture equilibrium from dry side in the standard atmosphere of 65  $\pm 2$  per cent relative humidity and 27 $\pm$  2 deg C temperature as laid down in IS 6359.

#### 5. Sampling and Criteria for Conformity:

As per IS specification of the IS Specification No. IS14968:2015 and latest amended up to date.

- a. The number of defective sacks in case of visual inspection ends, picks, & dimension is up to 10 percent of the sample size subject to rounding off the fraction to next higher integer.
- b. None of the sacks and bale of 300 and 500 sacks weighs less than 3 percent of specified value and calculated mass of bale respectively.
- c. The average breaking strength of fabric in both lengthwise & widthwise directions is not less than the value specified and none of the individual value is more than 10 percent below the specified value. The test shall be carried out on center portion of the sacks.
- d. 10 percent of the samples subject to rounding off the fraction to next higher integer, can have bottom seam strength up to 323 N (33 Kgf) in case of 50 Kg sack, provided that average specified seam strength of all the samples under test is 363 N(37Kgf) in case of 50 Kg sack.
- e. No sack shall have percentage of elongation outside the specified range.
- f. None of the samples after exposing to UV radiation & weathering shall have breaking strength less than 50 percent of the original breaking strength.

g. As per Central Marks Department -2 CMD-2/16:14968 Page 280 dated 26.06.2022 Clause 4 " It is submitted that the above change has been effected through this amendment since through earlier amendment no. 3 the thickness of the liner had been increased due to which the mass of the sack with liner needs to be accordingly modified and tolerances on mass specified. There is no change required in the existing product manual/SIT on account of this amendment."

Bidders to quote offer their rates considering above mentioned scope of job.

#### **Delivery Period:**

Delivery of item shall be done purely on call up basis in writing / e-mail from respective plants and shall be strictly as per quantity mentioned in the call up letter. Call up letter shall be issued by HBL Plant Officer in Charge of the delivery location from time to time. Delivery period against each call up shall be within 15 days from the date of receipt of the call up letter failing which delayed delivery clause shall be applicable and may also lead to termination of the contract.

Please Note: No verbal call up shall be entertained. In the event it is found that materials are delivered without written call up letter then HBL shall reject such materials and entire responsibility and cost implication shall be on the supplier's account and HBL will not be liable for any Payments in this regard.

- 1. P.O. shall be placed among two suppliers in the ratio of 60:40 for Each Location. L1 will be given 60% quantity of the tender and L2 will be given 40% of the quantity, subject to L2 matches the L1 rate.
- 2. Delivery Period: The delivery period shall be within 15 days from the date of intimation via mail/call up/letter/Call up orders.
- 3. Purchase Order validity: The Purchase order when placed shall be valid for 12 months from the date of LOI / Purchase Order, whichever is earlier for delivery on lot basis as per HBL's advice.
- 4. Supplier will be advised to deliver the items on Fax/e-mail or telephone, Advice provided on telephone will be confirmed by e-mail/fax within 24 hours.
- 5. All the applicable taxes, transit insurance, transportation charges, are in supplier's scope. (Including Panchayat, Municipal Tax etc. applicable in Bihar related to the above work).
- 6. Road Permit/Way Bill Clause: With effect from 1st Feb 2018 onward e-way bill shall be issued through national portal of GST E-Way bill website address. Kindly visit the below address for issuing E-way bill <a href="https://ewaybill2.nic.in/ewbnat3/">https://ewaybill2.nic.in/ewbnat3/</a>

- 7. The items mentioned in the tender are required to run the plants and no delay in delivery will be acceptable.
- 8. Supplier shall immediately send replacement load of items in another lorry/consignment in case of any accidents or breakdown of vehicle and likely hood of items not reaching units on desired date/time.
- 9. HBL shall have right to get the material tested from any reputed Laboratory and check the quality of material at the cost of the supplier. In case it is found the materials are not meeting the specification mentioned in the purchase order HBL will have the right to reject the material and no payment for the lot shall be made this also result in termination of the contract.
- 10. Supplier shall submit the test report of supplied material along with the Invoice or LR.

#### 11. Delayed delivery:

Timely delivery is the essence of this contract. In the event of delayed delivery beyond the above stipulated 15 days from the date of receipt of call-up letter penalty shall be levied @ 0.5% on the undelivered lot value for delay per week subject to maximum @5% of the total call up order value.

#### 12. Procurement at Risk and Cost:

In case of delay in delivery beyond 15 days from the date of delivery period of call up letter, HBL shall have unilateral right to procure the required materials from any other supplier from open market at supplier's risk and cost. Differential cost if any shall be recovered from pending bills, retention money, and security deposits available with HBL. The risk and cost clause shall be applicable in addition to delayed **delivery clause No. 8** 

- 13. Wherever HPCL or HBL is mentioned in this tender all references shall have the meaning of HPCL Biofuels Limited, having its registered office at 1st Floor, Shree Sadan, Plot No. 09, Patliputra Colony, Patna 800013, Bihar.
- 14. Supplier shall send the materials/items in a manner that it reaches unit gate in 1<sup>st</sup> half of the working day so that the vehicles can be released without delay.

HBL shall Endeavour to allow unloading of vehicles reporting upto 14:00 hrs in second half, however vehicles reporting after 14:00 hrs shall be unloaded on next working day only. No demurrage on account of late release of vehicle shall be paid by HBL.

Vehicle once allowed inside the unit premises shall be allowed to leave unit premises during working hours only. Beyond working hours departure shall be permitted only under special cases after obtaining necessary approvals, as laid down in the plant.

#### 15. Validity of the Auction:

The bids of bidder's shall be valid for a period of 10 working days from the date of e-auction for confirmation of winner.

#### 16. Purchase Order validity:

The Purchase order when placed shall be valid for 12 months for execution from the date of LOI / Purchase Order, for delivery on lot basis as per HBL's advice.

### 17. EMD Requirements:

Participant shall deposit Rs. 5,00,000/- for Part-A- and Rs. 5,00,000/- for Part-B. Participant interested to participate for both parts shall pay Rs. 10,00,000/- Only those bidders will be allowed to participate in the e-Auction, who has deposited the EMD amount before bidding. Once the auction initiated, NeML will not entertain the request of EMD deposit/confirmation.

This EMD will be returned to unsuccessful bidder if no allocation is given and EMD of successful bidder will be converted into security deposit.

The EMD of successful bidders are converted into Security Deposit (SD) and shall be returned after successful completion of the contract, after getting confirmation from HBL and TDS applicable as per income tax act.

- 18. NeML Transaction charge: **0.50% + GST (@18%)** of total bid value in their respective Escrow accounts issued by NCDEX e Markets Limited to participate in the auction.
- 19. Purchase order shall be awarded to successful bidders after completion of necessary auction formalities. Quoted prices shall be "Free to Destination Basis" and shall remain fixed and firm until completion of contract.

#### 21. PAYMENT TERMS:

- Part payment for part deliveries on load basis shall be made, on the basis material receipt certification by officer in charge of respective locations along with test certificate (if required)
- b. 100% of supply payments along with taxes & duties against the supply items shall be made within **30 days** of receipt of correct invoices at HPCL Biofuels Limited, Sugauli/Lauriya.
- c. All payments shall be disbursed by RTGS/NEFT from our HPCL Biofuels Ltd, Patna.

#### 22. Order Quantity:

The quantity ordered shall be construed as tentative, and HBL has unilateral right to reduce the quantities against any item/s for part delivery or nil delivery against any items. All payments shall be made basis actual quantity of items received at respective unit locations mentioned above.



#### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### 1. PRELIMINARY

- i. This is a Contract for the supply of "PP Bags" as defined in the auction (RFP) document for the specified locations
- ii. Participant for the above-mentioned supply is the company/proprietary concern and undersigned is authorized to submit the bid on behalf of participant.
- iii. The terms and conditions mentioned hereunder are the terms and conditions of the Contract for the execution of the supply mentioned under item 1.1 above.
- iv. It is the clear understanding between HPCL BIOFUELS LTD and the participants that in case the bid of participant is accepted by HPCL BIOFUELS LTD and an intimation & purchase order to that effect is so issued to the participant. These documents shall form part of the Contract between the bidders and terms and conditions hereunder would govern the bidders' interest.
- v. Interpretation of Contract documents: All the documents forming part of the contract are to be taken as self-explanatory should there be any discrepancy, inconsistency, error or omission in the contract, the decision of the plant-in-Charge shall be the final and binding on the member. The decision shall not be arbitral.

#### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- i. The COMPANY means HPCL BIOFUELS LTD, all references to HPCL or HBL in this auction all references shall have the same meaning as HPCL Biofuels Limited, having its registered office at 1st Floor, Shree Sadan, Plot No. 09, Patliputra Colony, Patna 800013, Bihar, and shall include its successors and assignees.
- ii. The term 'contract' shall mean and include the invitation to participate in the auction, incorporating also the instruction to participants. The e-auction RFP, its annexure and the auction schedule, acceptance of successful bidder and such general and special conditions and any amendments to certain Clauses of tender as may be added to it.
- iii. The term 'NeML' wherever occurs shall mean NCDEX e Markets Limited.
- iv. The term 'Bidder/Seller/Participant' shall mean the person, firm or company to whom this purchase order is issued.
- v. The term 'Buyer' shall mean HBL, who is requiring "PP Bags" by them which is put up purchase by this e-Auction.
- vi. The term 'e-Auction' or 'electronic auction' means submission of the online bids by the Seller(s)/bidder(s) for the "PP Bags" intended for purchase via the internet, over a prescribed time period.

- vii. The term 'Reverse auction' means a descending price auction where several participants compete to offer the best price and the buyer will accept the competitive price. The buyer specifies the opening bid and bid lowering and optionally a reserve price. Each bidder shall submit a successively lower bid. At the end of the auction, bidders with the lowest bid win subject to terms and conditions of the RFP.
- viii. Total Order Value Means: -

For Material Supply Contract: - The basic cost excluding taxes, duties, levies, freight etc. unless and until specifically mentioned in the purchase order.

#### 3. CONFIRMATION OF ORDER

The supplier shall acknowledge the receipt of the Purchase Order within 10 days following the mailing of this order and shall thereby confirm his acceptance of this Purchase Order in its entirety without exceptions.

#### 4. COMPLETE AGREEMENT

The terms and conditions of this Purchase Order shall constitute the entire agreement between the participants hereto. Changes will be binding only if the amendments are made in writing and signed by an authorized representative of the company and the supplier.

#### 5. PACKING AND MARKING

The Materials shall be suitably packed for safe transportation until receipt at the site and should be commensurate with best possible practices of packing. The Supplier shall be liable for all damages or breakage to the material due to defective or insufficient packing.

#### 6. WEIGHTS AND MEASUREMENTS

All weights and measurements recorded by the Company on receipt of goods at site will be treated as final.

Supplier's shipping documents and invoices must contain the following data:

- a) Unit net weight
- b) Unit gross weight (packing included)
- c) Dimensions of packing.

#### 7. INSPECTION-CHECKING-TESTING

The material covered by the Purchase Order shall be subject to inspection and testing at any time prior to shipment and or dispatch and to final inspection within a reasonable time after arrival at the place of delivery. Quality Inspectors shall have the right to carry out the inspection and testing which will include the raw materials at manufacturer's place and at the time of actual dispatch before and after completion of packing. All tests required will be performed at the supplier's expenses and in accordance with Quality Inspector's instructions.

#### 8. SHIPMENT AND SHIPMENT NOTICES

Within 24 hours of shipment, Supplier shall inform dispatch particulars to Company by fax/courier/email. The supplier shall carefully note the delivery destination of "PP Bags".

The demurrage or other expenses incurred owing to any negligence, delay, and default on the part of the supplier will be on supplier's account.

#### 9. TRANSIT RISK:

Transit Risk insurance shall be covered by the Supplier.

#### 10. CONTROL REGULATIONS

The supply, dispatch and delivery of goods shall be arranged by the Vendor in strict conformity with the statutory regulations including provision of Industries (Development and Regulation) Act 1951 and any amendment thereof as applicable from time to time. The Company disowns any responsibility for any irregularity or contravention of any of the statutory regulations in manufacture or supply of the stores covered by this order.

### 11. PRICE REDUCTION FOR DELAYED DELIVERY

In case of delayed delivery, prices will be reduced @0.50% of the total contract order value for every week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of @5% of the total contract order value.

**NOTE:** Price reduction shall be applicable only on the total contract value and on full complete week(s) and for fractional days price reduction shall be applicable on pro-rata, if any.

#### 12. DELAYS DUE TO FORCE MAJEURE

Any delay in or failure of the performance of either part hereto shall not constitute default hereunder or give rise to any claims for damage, if any, to the extent such delays or failure of performance is caused by occurrences such as Acts of God or an enemy, expropriation or confiscation of facilities by Government authorities, acts of war, rebellion, sabotage or fires, floods, pandemic, explosions, riots, or strikes. The supplier shall keep records of the circumstances referred to above and bring these to the notice of the Plant-in-Charge in writing immediately on such occurrences. The amount of time, if any, lost on any of these counts shall not be counted for the contract period. Once decision of the Buyer arrived at after consultation with the seller, which shall be final and binding to both the parties. Such determined period of time is extended by the buyer to enable the seller to complete the delivery within such extended period of time.

# 13. REJECTION, REMOVAL OF REJECTED GOODS AND REPLACEMENT

In case the quality checking and inspection by the Plant-In-Charge reveal that the material does not comply with specification and requirements, the same shall be removed by the supplier at
